All parents are invited to visit their child's class, see the work that they have done during the term and speak to the teachers about their child's progress.

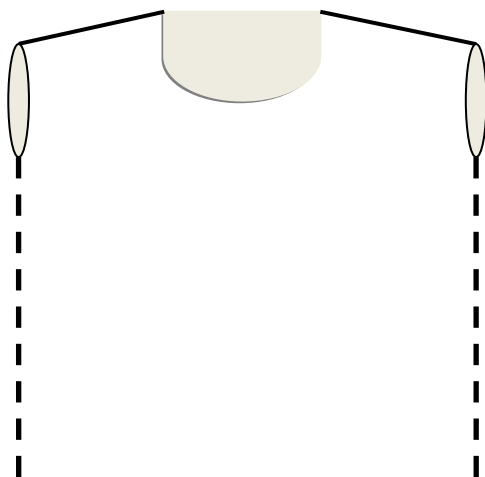
We remind parents that there will be no lunch this day and all children should be collected at 12.30 pm from the playground.

Colour of the satin:

K0: White

K1: Gold

K2: Red

K3: Green

Suggestion: *Round neck with small opening at the back with a small fastener.*
