Rationale

Canterbury School holds high expectations and standards for our pupils and requires pupils to wear a uniform. We encourage our pupils to wear their uniform with pride marking their distinct identity as part of the Canterbury community. Uniform sets an appropriate tone, supporting positive behaviour and discipline. It also supports pupils in learning how to dress appropriately and in learning how to dress in a manner appropriate to the activity being undertaken and the environment they are in.

Uniform

Uniform must be worn correctly at all times. At Canterbury School we have a *school uniform and a PE uniform*.

It is important that all items of uniform are marked with the pupil's name.

Uniform is worn from Year 1 to Year 11. It is generally worn from mid-October until mid-April. (These dates are flexible depending on the weather).

PE uniform is worn in Pre-Nursery, Nursery and Reception all year round.



The **school uniform** consists of:

- A dark green polo shirt with the school crest. (Long sleeved vests are not permitted underneath the polo shirt)
- A navy blue pullover or cardigan (With or without the school crest).
- Navy blue fleece (Optional in cold weather. With or without the school crest)
- Navy blue socks.
- Navy blue tights (Optional)
- Navy blue or black leather shoes. (Trainers or boots are not permitted)
- Grey tailored trousers or shorts (Canvas trousers are not permitted), school tartan skirt.
- In cold weather a sleeveless or short sleeved vest can be worn underneath the polo shirt.
- In cold weather a navy blue coat may also be worn. (With or without the school crest)
- In cold weather a navy blue scarf/buff or woolly hat may be worn in the playground but should be taken off inside.

Pre-Nursery, Nursery & Reception children need a sleeveless plastic, tabard – style bib for lunch time.

PE Uniform

From Year 1 upwards the pupils come to school in their PE uniform on their PE days. From Year 5 onwards and in Secondary, whenever possible, pupils should bring items to freshen up after PE and change their T-shirt.

PE uniform consists of:

- A white Canterbury School T-shirt
- Green Canterbury School shorts
- White socks
- White trainers (Basketball trainers are not permitted)
- Canterbury School tracksuit
- A cap for outside activities and break times

Summer Months

PE uniform is worn from Pre-Nursery to Year 11. It is generally worn at the start and end of the academic year when the weather is hot. The exception to this is Pre-Nursery, Nursery and Reception who wear the PE uniform throughout the year.

Dress Code

When wearing the school uniform polo-shirts must be tucked in to skirts and trousers.

Extreme hair styles and colours (including patterns or lines) are not allowed in school. For health and safety reasons pupils with long hair must wear it tied back.

A wristwatch may be worn and up to 2 plain stud earrings. No other jewellery should be worn.

Makeup, nail varnish or false nails are not allowed.

Piercings and tattoos are not allowed.

No other headgear is permitted apart from those stipulated in the policy.

Uniform may be purchased from the school office, by ordering it in advance from the department that your child attends, or from El Corte Inglés.
