Rationale

Canterbury School holds high expectations and standards for our pupils and requires pupils to wear a uniform. We encourage our pupils to wear their uniform with pride marking their distinct identity as part of the Canterbury community. Uniform sets an appropriate tone, supporting positive behaviour and discipline. It also supports pupils in learning how to dress appropriately and in learning how to dress in a manner appropriate to the activity being undertaken and the environment they are in.

Uniform

Uniform must be worn correctly at all times. At Canterbury School we have a school uniform and a P.E. uniform. **It is important that all items of uniform are marked with the pupil's name.**

The uniform in the Infant Department (Pre-Nursery to Year 1)

Pupils in this department wear only the P.E. uniform throughout the entire school year. Therefore, from Pre-Nursery to Year 1, they only need to purchase this uniform.

Additionally, Pre-Nursery, Nursery, and Reception students will need a sleeveless plastic bib for the dining room.

The uniform in the Junior and Senior Departments (from Year 2 to Year 11)

In the primary and secondary departments, pupils generally wear the school uniform from mid-October to mid-April (these dates are flexible depending on the weather) and the P.E. uniform during the warmer months and on days when they have P.E. classes.

The **school uniform** consists of:

- A dark green polo shirt with the school crest. (Long sleeved vests are not permitted underneath the polo shirt)
- A navy-blue pullover or cardigan (With or without the school crest). No hoodies are allowed.



- Navy blue fleece (Optional in cold weather. With or without the school crest)
- Navy blue socks.
- Navy blue tights (Optional)
- Navy blue or black leather shoes. (Trainers or boots are not permitted.)
- Grey tailored trousers or shorts (Canvas trousers are not permitted), school tartan skirt.
- In cold weather a sleeveless or short sleeved vest can be worn underneath the polo shirt.
- In cold weather a navy blue coat may also be worn. (With or without the school crest)
- In cold weather a navy blue scarf/buff or woolly hat may be worn in the playground but should be taken off inside.

The P.E. uniform consists of:

- A white Canterbury School T-shirt
- Green Canterbury School shorts
- White socks
- White trainers (Basketball trainers are not permitted)
- Canterbury School tracksuit
- A cap for outside activities and break times

Pupils from Year 2 onwards should come to school wearing their P.E. uniform on the days they have P.E. From Year 5 to Year 11, whenever possible, they should freshen up and change their shirt after the class.

At the beginning and end of the academic year, due to the heat, pupils in both the Primary and Secondary departments may come to school in their P.E. uniform. We will inform you of the specific dates in advance.

Dress Code

- Extreme hair styles and colours are not allowed in school. For health and safety reasons, pupils with long hair must wear it tied back.
- A wristwatch may be worn and stud earrings. Only discreet jewellery may be worn.
- Makeup, nail varnish or false nails are not allowed.
- Piercings and tattoos are not allowed.

Uniform may be purchased from the school office, by ordering it in advance from the department that your child attends, or from El Corte Inglés.
